This week I want to share with you some of the discussions we had at tonight's Vestry meeting. You should know that the church is blessed with a faithful, thoughtful, and dedicated team of leaders. Our Wardens are Bert Bookhout, Margo Kowalczyk, and Emera Bridger Wilson (*emerita*). Vestry members are Jan Bookhout, Meg Houston, Gelene Lewis, Gina Odell, Kiki White and Fred Wilson. Treasurer Kathleen Eckermann and Vestry Clerk Kate Bell complete the group. While only the two Wardens and six Vestry members have a vote, the others actively participate in our discussions.

Memorial Garden: Sunday after the service we hope to have a computer generated design of the new garden to show you both in person and on Zoom. It is beautiful, twice the size of the current area, and includes a walkway from the sidewalk. The plants chosen by the designer all have religious significance, are native, and are deer resistant. Carolyn Bashaw, Margo Kowalczyk, Bobbi Lombardo and I were excited by the design when it was presented to us last week. We're looking at June or July for the work to be done. Many thanks to Carolyn Bashaw for suggesting and financing this wonderful project.

<u>2022 Pledges</u>: So far we have received 21 pledges, 9 of which were increased from 2021. We expect to hear from at least 2 more people. Thank you for your generosity and dedication to St. Alban's!

<u>Coffee Hour</u>: The group that enjoyed fellowship on the ramp after the service wanted us to know that their time together was as much a joy with a simple offering of food as it was when we were indoors with a laden table. It was easier to volunteer to bring food because simplicity was expected and one didn't have to get out of the car juggling trays. The Vestry all heartily agreed that simple was preferred. Also, when we have a festive coffee hour for a holy day it is set apart from the normal fare. So, the Vestry is asking people to bring something simple and sweet, along with cheese and crackers. We also will begin offering coffee again as soon as someone brings in coffee!


