Dear Friends,

My son Russell and his wife Shelby are moving back home after living in Florida for two years. Unfortunately, my son has now been furloughed twice. They will live with us for several months and have jobs lined up after they quarantine for two weeks. My family will be topsy-turvy for those two weeks. Russell, Shelby and their puppy will live at the house with Chris and our two dogs.

September 23-27 Brian and I will be in a hotel. After church on the 27th I will go home.

Sept. 27-Oct. 9 I will be in quarantine at home. Brian will spend 2 weeks at the hotel so

he can continue to work at SU.

The only thing that will be affected at St. Alban's is the 9:30 a.m. service on October 4, which will be Morning Prayer led by Steve Pekich. I will provide a sermon for him to read. Everything else I can do on Zoom, as I did when church buildings were closed. The YouTube service for October 4 will be recorded before I am in quarantine and the bulletin sent out at the usual time.

First Part of the Lesson from the Hebrew Scripture for September 20

The whole congregation of the Israelites complained against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness. The Israelites said to them, "If only we had died by the hand of the LORD in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the fleshpots and ate our fill of bread; for you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger."

Then the LORD said to Moses, "I am going to rain bread from heaven for you, and each day the people shall go out and gather enough for that day. In that way I will test them, whether they will follow my instruction or not. On the sixth day, when they prepare what they bring in, it will be twice as much as they gather on other days." So Moses and Aaron said to all the Israelites, "In the evening you shall know that it was the LORD who brought you out of the land of Egypt, and in the morning you shall see the glory of the LORD, because he has heard your complaining against the LORD. For what are we, that you complain against us?" And Moses said, "When the LORD gives you meat to eat in the evening and your fill of bread in the morning, because the LORD has heard the complaining that you utter against him."

This lesson is reminding me to look at what I do have, instead of what I don't have. Yes, I'll have to quarantine - again. Yes it will be hard and I will miss those who do come to St. Alban's in person. Most especially, Brian and I will be separated for most of that time. However, here's what I do have: a wonderful husband, my kids moving back home (yay!), the people of St. Alban's, and Zoom.
